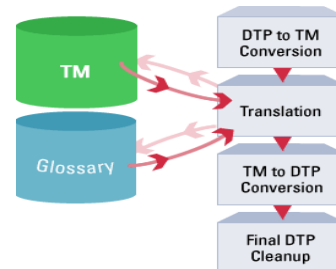

The most obvious users would be translators with repetitive texts. But it doesn't stop there, because most of the available packages include decent or good terminology management tools that can be widely used.

This informal presentation will give a very brief introduction to the general concept of these tools and their benefits. There will be a basic demonstration of SDL TRADOS Studio to illustrate the general capabilities of the TEnTs and you will be provided with a website where you can further explore several of these tools on your own time and decide if they are for you.
